Dolphin Tray





Material


one small watermelon

Equipment

sharp-pointed knife carving knife melon scoop

Instructions

- 1. Use an elongated watermelon.
- Draw a dolphin on the rind of the watermelon as in the picture.
- Cut along the lines carefully with the knife and then gently cut away the rind.
- 4. With a melon scoop, make the flesh into watermelon balls and set aside in the dish. Remove any remaining flesh so the interior is clean and white.
- Cut triangles through the rind to represent the eyes, and in the edges, cut notches to represent eyelashes.
- Cut a crescent for the mouth, and then notch the upper border of the rind all around except at the tail.
- Arrange the watermelon and cantaloupe balls attractively in the dolphin.
